### OPENING MEDITATION

Holy God, we are Easter people, people of hope and resurrection, but a lot of days still seem like Good Friday. We feel stuck in pain and loss, fear and anxiety, worry and doubt. Resurrection power seems to be in short supply, and we are not sure how your power impacts the difficulties and suffering we face. Renew us again, dear Friend. Come alongside us and speak words of grace and truth to us. Open our eyes to your constant presence and remind us that you are always working out your redemptive purposes in our lives and in our world. Amen.

### LITANY CALL TO WORSHIP FOR EASTER PEOPLE

Voice 1: Walking with Christ is a journey of faith.

**Voice 2: We may not know where God is leading.**

Voice 1: We may not see a clear path in front of us.

**Voice 2: We may not understand our circumstances.**

Voice 1: We likely won't have answers to the "why" questions.

**Voice 2: We sometimes won't like what unfolds along the way.**

Voice 1: Hardship, suffering, illness and loss challenge us and require great trust.

**Voice 2: We won't always see God's hand or recognize God's voice.**

Voice 1: Walking with Christ is a journey of faith.

**Voice 2: Therefore, we choose to trust even in the midst of doubt or fear.**

Voice 1: We look for evidences of God's grace and mercy.

**Voice 2: We hope in the One whose faithfulness and love are never ending.**

**All: Let us walk with Christ this day. Hallelujah! Amen.**

### PRAYER OF CONFESSION

**Merciful Savior, although blind, we think we see. We are blind to your presence among us in those who are poor or lonely. We have made invisible those who are mentally or emotionally ill. We must remember the silent cries of children living with unimaginable and unrelenting abuse. We ignore the refugee, the hungry or homeless --**

what, after all, can we do to make a difference in the midst of such overwhelming need? We convince ourselves that you came to save people just like us, and, therefore, what concerns us must concern you. For our pride and self-centeredness, Lord, we ask your forgiveness. For our lack of compassion and our complicity in the inequities between peoples, we confess our sin. Open our eyes and our hearts to see the truth, and turn us away from ourselves that we might desire and pursue your way of righteousness, justice and peace. We thank you for your mercy which is greater than all our sin. For the sake of Christ, we pray. Amen.
