

# Jake Gill to perform during Sunday worship at First Presbyterian Church

A performer whose talents carried him to stardom on “The Voice,” will be the special musical guest during a Sunday morning worship in Jefferson City.

Jake Gill and his band will perform a number of songs during the 9:30 a.m. worship at First Presbyterian Church, 324 Madison St.

The entire church will be open for the event, with extended seating available, according to the Rev. Angela Madden, the church’s senior pastor.

The good news, Madden said, is participants won’t have to open any hymnals — leave that up to Gill.

After his 2012 stint on “The Voice,” Gill won a song writing contest and became the opening act for Jason

Aldean at the Country Stampede, a three-day music festival. Following God’s guidance, Gill has toured full time since 2014, according to a news release. He has performed with numerous recording greats.

But Gill, who is from Kansas, still loves performing in churches, coffee houses and fairs, the release said.
